

## Future Academy provides humanitarian support, education, sport and enrichment activities for conflict-affected children in Beirut.

In the past 2 weeks, life in Lebanon has changed forever: the terror of exploding pagers and walkie talkies has escalated to the bombing and destruction of whole neighbourhoods. It is estimated that 1,000 people have been killed and one million residents displaced. Whole villages have been wiped out in southern Lebanon and the southern suburbs of Beirut are in ruins. Alongside our established programmes in Burj Barajneh and Shaila refugee camps, our outreach volunteers are delivering humanitarian support and education in pop-up classrooms in Beirut. These sessions are providing a lifeline to the increasing numbers of street kids and vulnerable displaced children.

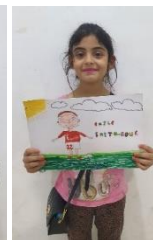
